Street Survivor, 1966 Plymouth Satellite









Robert purchased this car a couple of years ago from a former club member. As far as I can tell, the car has never been wrecked, but it has lived in some rather bad places to be a car. (Florida, New Jersey, New York, and Ohio) It has some bondo, and a little rust, but it is a Factory 383 4-speed car. I'm 99% sure it is the original engine also. I have some documentation that the second owner had the engine rebuilt "back in the day" (1971) by the same guy that did machining for Big Daddy Don Garlits. He ported and polished a set



of 516 Heads for the car. These were early closed chamber heads, prior to the 915's used on the 67 GTX and had smaller valves. TRW domed pistons, a Crane H 302 NC cam, Offenhauser dual quad intake, Headers, Mallory Hy-Fire ignition, Zoom Clutch and Flywheel. Additional mods were a SFI Steel bellhousing and a deepened oil pan. Back in '71, deep oil pans weren't as readily available as they are now, and this one was hand made from the original by cutting it in two and welding in a section.

The same was done to the oil pick up tube as well. Old school hot rod stuff!



After I got the car, naturally I took it to the track. I made a few passes at Xtreme and at the Motorplex. On my last pass at the Motorplex, when I got back to the pits there was a stream of water spraying out of the right front corner where the head meets the block. UGH. I could have just pulled the head and replaced the gasket, but it really needed new gaskets all around, and there was this bearing noise coming from the transmission. I took the heads to Dave to check them out. He said they looked good and I had him install some posi loc valve seals. I also had him resurface the flywheel, since the clutch needed to be replaced also. In the meantime, I tore into the transmission to replace the bearings and seals. I was hoping it was the input bearing but it wasn't. Nothing is ever easy. There is a needle bearing between the Main Shaft and the Input Shaft where the Input shaft serves as the outer race and the Main Shaft serves as the inner race. Luckily, I was able to get Dave to sleeve the end of the Main Shaft and replace the Input Shaft. So now I have a completely rebuilt transmission also.





After all of that, I wanted something better than the old Mallory Dual Point/Hy-Fire ignition. I opted for a new MSD Pro Billet Distributor and Digital 6 AL module with 8.5 mm MSD wires and Blaster coil. It is finally all back together and, on the road, again. Looking forward to getting it back to the track!




Single membership is still \$25, and Family membership remains at \$40. Current members need not fill out a membership form for renewal unless a change is needed for membership information the Club has on file.
