Carona Charger

Hello everyone, Craig Bush here again. First, I want to thank Ron for the great job he does on the newsletter. I figure some of you might get tired of my drivel and will send him some on your own for the newsletter....

Anyway, I had a salvage dealers license for about 15 years and bought hundreds of "totaled" cars and motorcycles from insurance company auctions at Copart and Insurance Auto Auction (IAAI). I let my license lapse a few years ago but have a friend that is still signed up with IAAI. I would like to have a late model Scat Pack Charger but there is one digit too many to the left of the decimal point on the price tag..... I was looking at the Chargers on IAAI web site and while it is not a late model, I did find a 07 Charger R/T that State Farm was selling after they declared it a 'total loss". State Farm paid out \$8,600 to the owner, the estimate of repairs was roughly \$6,000......the damage didn't look too bad to me so I had my buddy put a bid on it for me. Long story short I "won", this was back in February. We all know what has happened since thus the name Carona Charger. This project kept me busy (when I felt like it) over the past couple of months. Buying a vehicle sight unseen (via pictures only) can be exciting but I got lucky on this one, there were two reasons I was interested; the mileage (73,000) and the damage didn't appear too bad. It needed a left front fender and door, there is a very small dent in the left rear door and the left quarter panel needs some body work.









After the tow truck dropped it off, I snatched the battery out of it (the auction houses generally run down the batteries on purpose), went and bought a new battery, installed it, fired it up, drove around the block and parked it in the garage. I then scoured the salvage yards for a white fender and door, I am not really happy with the ones I ended up with but the newest used parts for this body style are 10 years old. The headlights were pretty foggy so I sanded and polished them, also the aftermarket wheels (would not have been my first choice) needed the clear coat removed as it was looking pretty bad.









I call this "piddling" and feel it helps me with my Parkinsons symptoms. I also did normal service work like oil and filter, air and cabin filters and new spark plugs. The interior cleaned up very nice, I had two worn panels repaired on the driver's seat. Yes, this car will have a "rebuilt salvage title".... for what I have in it I am happy. As I write this, I still need to get an inspection done and the registration in my name. I hope to run some TMCCC events with it, I don't want to beat on my Duster with the current engine that is in.


Single membership is still \$25, and Family membership remains at \$40. Current members need not fill out a membership form for renewal unless a change is needed for membership information the Club has on file.



This is a sound straight bodied Muscle Car that has been parked in storage buildings. The vehicle was driven and parked in the fall of 1981, last state inspection sticker was 1985, and had anticipation of restoring it back to its original condition when time permitted. The engine and transmission were rebuilt before it was parked and has from 10 to 15,000 miles on them, and has not been started in a long time. There were plans to restore the vehicle in the next few years, unfortunately heath conditions will not allow this to take place. From what can be seen, the vinyl top will have to be replaced, while it is off, there is some rust under it. The driver's side fender was replaced years ago, but it looks like it was installed correctly. The body will need to be repainted, and since you will want to pull the motor and freshen it up, paint the engine bay as well. The bucket seats look in good condition, along with the dash, but the carpet will need replacing. We are asking \$18,000 for this solid muscle car. This can be restored back to either a driver or a show car depending on your needs. There are photos attached.
