What's a MOPAR?

Section "D"

What Is a Mopar?

Used colloquially, "Mopar" means any Chrysler, Plymouth, Dodge, DeSoto, Ram, or Jeep vehicle, with an emphasis on classic or vintage models.

Mopar is the original-equipment replacement and aftermarket accessory parts division of Stellantis car brands distributed in North America.

Mopar muscle cars are performance variants of Plymouth, Dodge, and Chrysler cars built during the muscle car era (1964 to 1972). Over time, third-gen Hemi performers will increasingly be considered part of this group.

The Mopar brand is now owned by Stellantis, which came from a merger of auto conglomerates FCA and PSA consummated in January 2021.

There is no actual car brand called "Mopar." Mopar has been widely conflated to mean cars of North American Chrysler Corp. lineage. Mopar occasionally offers branded vehicles (through limited dealership channels) equipped with Mopar parts and accessories.

A car of interest that made an 80 mile drive to the track was a 70 Dodge Dart convertible with a Hellcat transplant along with the 8 speed automatic. This was his first time to the track and he posted a couple of traction limited (even with 275 drag radials) times of 6.40 in the 1/8 mile. For comparision Terry runs 8.30 and I run 9.00 in my Charger, that Dart was flying.
