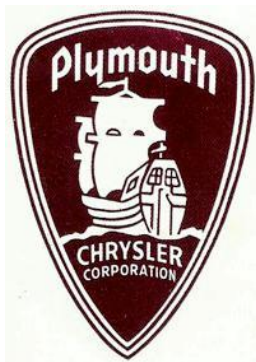

The meeting in May will be on May 15th, the 3rd Sunday of May. We always move it so we don't conflict with Mothers' Day.

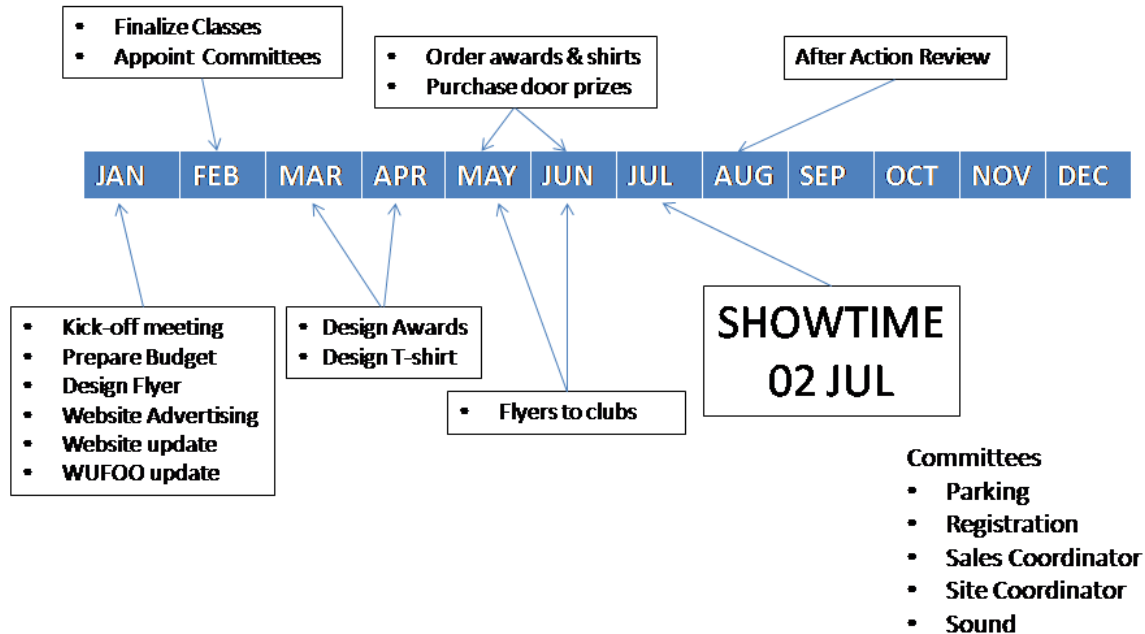
The 50/50 pot had a total of \$32, so \$16 was won by Steve Jones with the winning ticket number. Then, Steve won again with his blue '68 Dart.

The meeting was adjourned at 3:15pm.

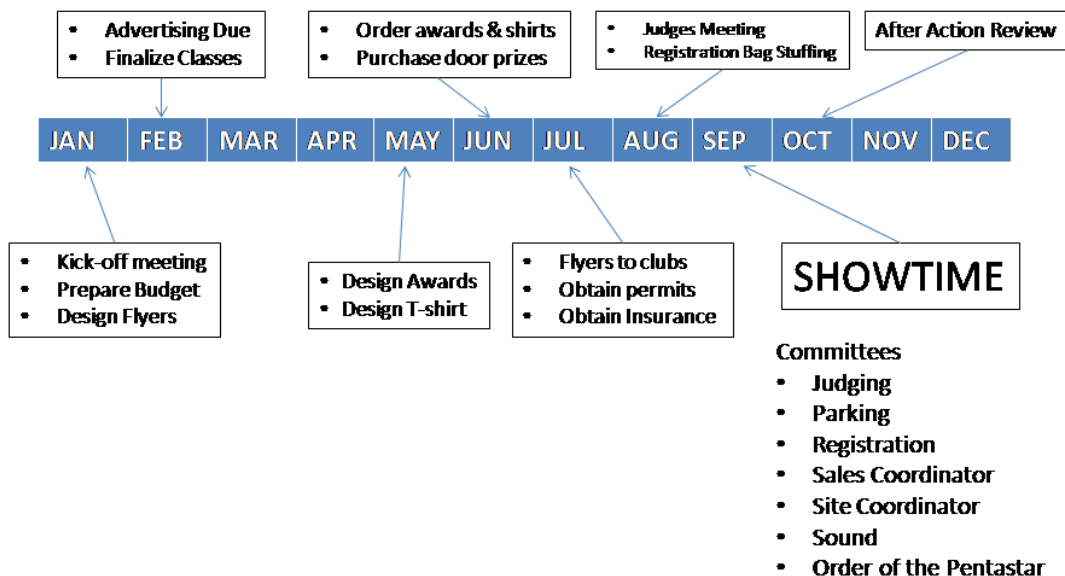

### 1968 Roadrunner & Mopar Magic show Submitted by: Tony Feger

I discovered the car was for sale from a friend of mine in Canada. I contacted the owner and he said was thinking about selling it. We talked about price and as negotiations go we agreed on a price based on my inspection of the car. The car was located in Winnipeg Canada. I flew to Winnipeg in late May 2014. The owner picked me up at the airport and we proceeded to his garage to inspect the car. He was in his mid-60's and had other cars in his collection. The Roadrunner was the only Mopar. He purchased the car in 2006 and didn't know any history. He had a car lift in the garage so it made the under carriage inspection easy. The car was as he described except for some items that were not correct. Mainly the wrong carb's were installed somewhere along the line. The car was very nice overall with a 12 year old restoration but was driven as expected to car shows. I offered \$4,500 less than the agreed price before inspection as I knew the correct restored carbs were in the \$4,000 range. He agreed and we shook hands. My dream car since 1968 was mine. He also had an original correct starter, new vent windows, stock exhaust manifolds, (car had header on it) and other parts. I returned home very happy. I loader up my trailer and headed up to Winnipeg second week of June to pick up the car. Good trip up, no issues.

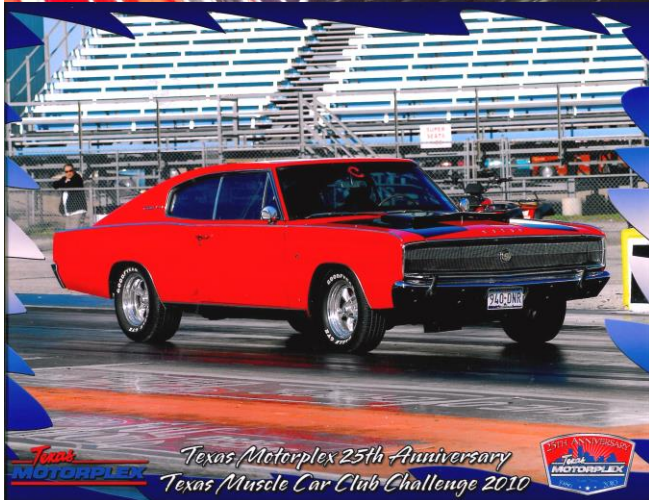
