
Kevin Matisse discussed how he is currently updating the website, and redesigning the club logo.... not a big redesign, just some needed tweeking to look better.




BILL MADSEN 1968 CHARGER




This 1968 H Code Charger was acquired in April 2007 out of Missouri. It then sat in my garage until November 2015. One of my clients has a salvage yard and body shop (with a very talented body man) in Van Alstyne. After analysis of the rust damage the necessary sheet metal was ordered from AMD. I also had a bare shell that I acquired in '07 from a rancher in the Oklahoma panhandle. We harvested the floor pans and many other bits and pieces from that shell.

The week before Thanksgiving the car was welded to a frame machine and the dismantling process began. The body man took careful measurements prior to the removal of the factory sheet metal. After 40 hours of work the outer wheelhouses, quarter panels, trunk pan and drop-offs, trunk filler panel, tail panel (from the shell), and rear valance had been replaced. During the process about 12" of rear frame rails from the shell had to be spliced in. In December rust in the upper rear window channel and one section of the front window channel were repaired. Used fenders are pretty scarce so an AMD patch panel was used to repair dogleg rust on the driver fender. Rust free doors that I acquired years ago were hung in place of the old rusty factory originals. Since these pictures were taken the doors, deck lid and hood have been paint stripped and put in primer.

I do tax work for a living so not much has been done to the car since January. I'm looking to get back on the project in the near future. My goal is to have it in paint and road worthy by next tax season. Needless to say I'm indebted to my client as I never would have accomplished all this work on my own.









