

We had a door prize to give away and Barbara Barnett won the \$25 gift certificate to Rock Auto.


The 50/50 pot was won by Jerry Reed, who won \$7.00






Tech Article

IBM Build Card for 1967 Chrysler Newport Custom

The Chrysler Historical services has Build Info for cars and trucks prior to 1967
Late 2015 I found that Chrysler Historical had a microfiche copy of the IBM shipping Build Card
for My 1967 Chrysler Newport. I ordered an email copy of the card and they sent me a copy of the card
and a write up on the serial number and the options that was installed on the car along with the ship
date. With this I now have the original build sheet and the original fender tag and all 3 agree with each
other.




Microfiche copy of IBM Build Sheet

Remade IBM Card

After looking everything over I found that the Dates looked wrong according to the what the fender tag, Build sheet and the IBM card indicated that the build date was B02 November 2,1966 but the actual ship date was 2 days earlier on October 31,1966. I guess the assembly line was ahead of schedule. So my car is a Halloween 1966 car. I also found that I was to have Shoulder belts in the car. And I had 2 6ft long belts rolled up under the rear seat (I thought prior owners put long belts in the car) the shoulder belts come from the back seat corners and over the front seat and driver /passenger. These belts don't have any play in them but what do you expect for 1st generation shoulder belts.

- Dodge Cars (1952, 1953, 1956, 1958)
 - There are no code sheets within the Historical Services for these years.
 - Only a build card is provided.


