The 50/50 pot of \$22 was won by Tony Feger. The favorite Mopar in the parking lot was won by Mark Wilson and he got \$21.


The meeting was adjourned at 3:15pm.





The Dallas Mopar Club finished the season in  $5^{\text{th}}$  place in the 3A Series of the Texas Muscle
























### Important Info from the Newsletter editor
