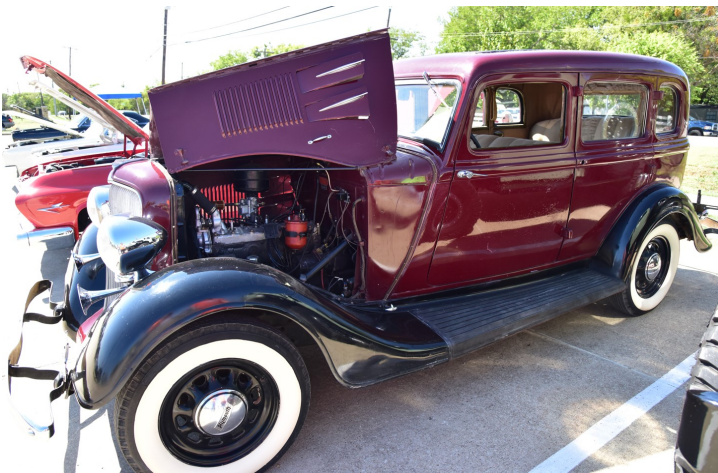

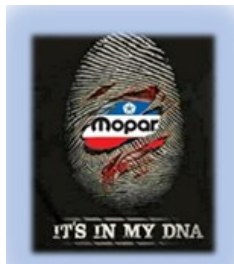

## Lone Star Shelby Dodge Car Club



The SDAC Lone Star Shelby Dodge Club Turbo's are back representing the 80s & 90s Dodge vehicles. Two 1986 Omni GLHS (Goes Like Hell Somemore) and a 1986 Charger GLHS made appearance at the Dallas MOPAR Nationals. The Dodge GLHS vehicles were Carrol Shelby's creation and the OMNI GLHS was the fastest 4 doors of the 1980s vintage US vehicles. Torque steer was prevalent on the GLHS models so you needed to hold on while playing with Blue Ovals and Bowties.

The '86 and '93 Dodge Daytona's had Carrol Shelby Intercooled Turbos and handing packages to improve FWD driving performance.

Lee Iacocca pulled Chrysler out of the grave in the 80's with the Front Wheel Drive and Turbo Charged Chrysler, Dodge & Plymouth vehicles. Carrol Shelby Turbo charged the '80s & '90s FWD cars for street performance.

## Time to Renew DMC Dues for 2024



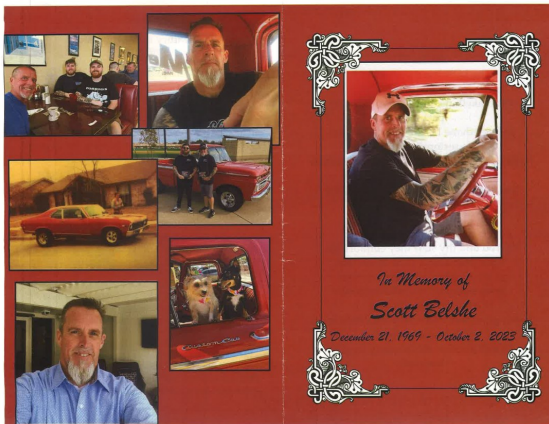

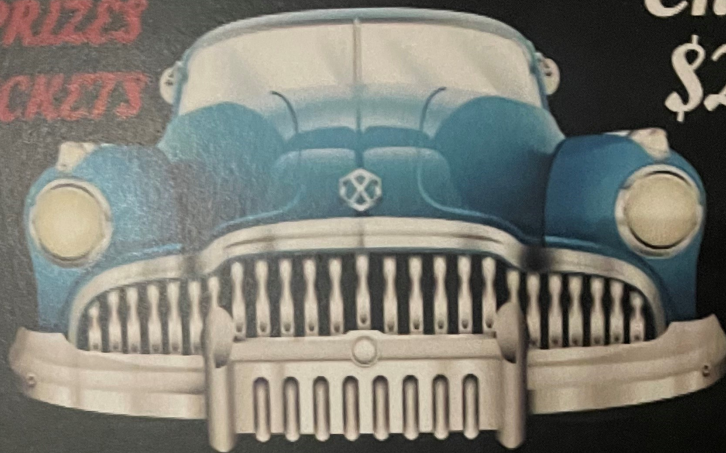
