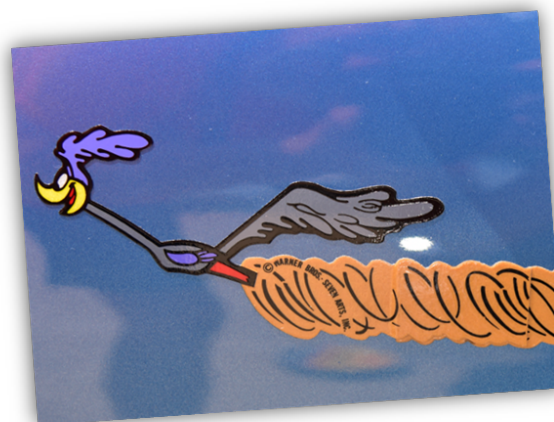

Dallas Mopar Club Meeting minutes 10-9-2022

Meeting occurred at VFW Post 5076 2180 Meridian Way, Garland 75040

Board /club meeting called to order at 1:57 PM by president Jerry Reed, 12 members were in attendance. Two new members were present; Steve West who owns a 1960 Dodge D100 truck, 2016 Scat Pack Challenger, SRT10 truck and a 1992 Daytona. Steve works at Streetside Classic used car sales in Ft Worth and invited us out anytime to have a look at their inventory. He said they average about 50 sales a month with 50 new arrivals a month, the inventory averages 300 cars. The second new member is David Horton who owns a 1972 GMC truck and a 1972 Plymouth Satellite. The Satellite was one of his first cars he owned, sold it and was able to buy it back 20 years later.

Andy Dicus presented a detailed financial report with numerous handouts. He went over the bank activity including a recap of the Mini-Nat's... The club in on solid financial footing.

Craig Bush gave a race report on the Texas Muscle Car Club Challenge (see the write up elsewhere in the newsletter).

Jerry Reed and Bob Gant both presented handouts that expressed their views on changes needed to make the Mini-Nat's run more efficiently. Some of the items to be considered are a name change to Southwest Mopar Nationals, reviewing the classes for possible consolidation, improving the judging time, recruiting more judges, trailer parking, trash cans on the show field, registration and judging stream lining, ensuring we have backups in place if there are unforeseen personnel shortages the day of the show, have a 'join the DMC' table, doing a "dress rehearsal" before the actual show. Jerry stated these items will be addressed in the coming months and possible some committees will be formed.

The Christmas party will be at Andy Dicus residence, 6613 CR4070 in Kemp, date and time to be decided at next month's meeting.

Jerry asked for any new business, there was none.

Jerry adjourned the meeting at 3:17PM.

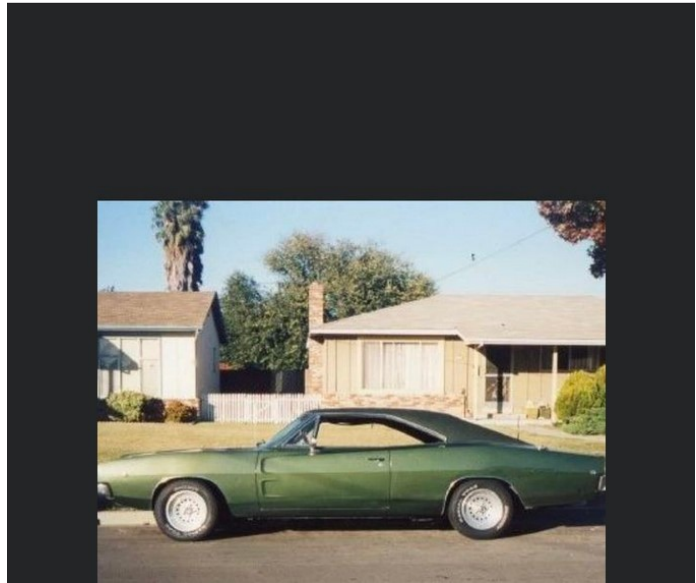
